PROJECT SUMMARY:

THIS PROJECT IS THE SIMPLE EXPANSION OF AN EXISTING TENANT SPACE INTO A VACANT ADJOINING TENANT SPACE, STUDIO 454 IS EXPANDING INTO THE FORMER FIORDALISO CHIROPRACTIC. THERE IS NO CHANGE OF "USE GROUP" & THE OCCUPANCY CLASSIFICATION IS THE SAME. THERE IS NO CHANGE TO BASIC HVAC OR LIGHTING SYSTEMS. THERE ARE SOME CHANGES TO THE PLUMBING SYSTEMS FOR TYPICAL SALON EQUIPMENT. NEW FINISHES WILL INTEGRATE THE SPACES.

ALL "PRIMARY FUNCTIONS" EXIST IN THE CURRENT SALON, AND SOME WILL BE DUPLICATED IN THE EXPANSION. THE EXPANSION CONTAINS NO NEW PRIMARY FUNCTIONS.

EXITS: THE TWO EXISTING SALON EXITS WILL BE MAINTAINED, THE EXITS IN THE EXPANSION WILL BE BLOCKED AND TAKEN OUT OF SERVICE, BUT NOT REMOVED FROM THE BUILDING.

ALTERATION "LEVEL ONE" IS DESCRIBED AS THE REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING FINISHES AND EQUIPMENT USING NEW THAT SERVE THE SAME PURPOSE.

2009 INTERNATIONAL EXISTING BUILDING CODE

IN GENERAL, THE EXISTING BUILDING CODE SAYS: WHATEVER YOU BUILD NEW, AND/OR WHAT EVER YOU SIGNIFICANTLY CHANGE, AND WHERE EVER YOU HAVE A CHANGE OF OCCUPANCY (USE GROUP), THEN ALL NEW AND ALTERED WORK WILL COMPLY WITH THE "INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE," THERE ARE SOME "EXCEPTIONS."

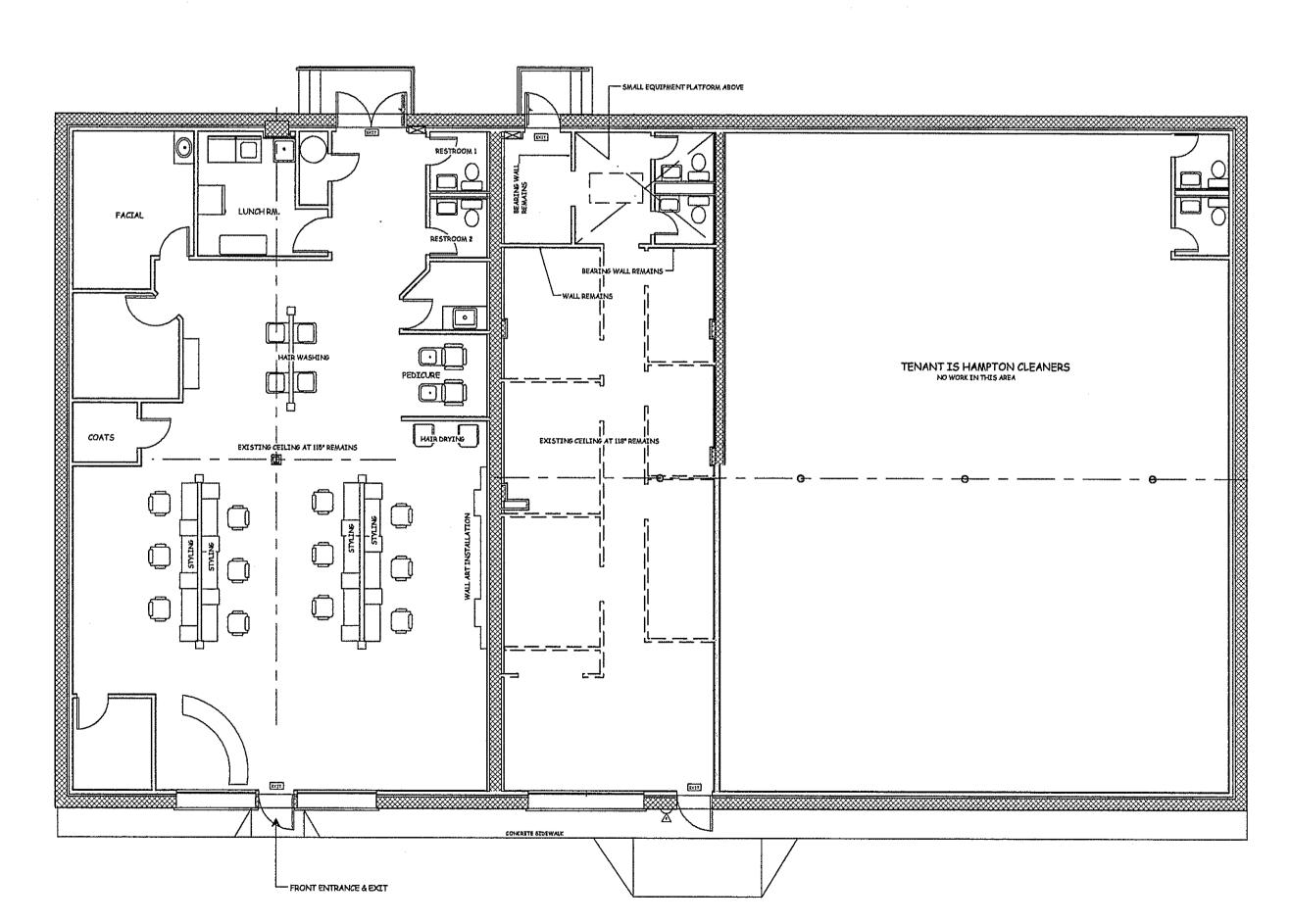

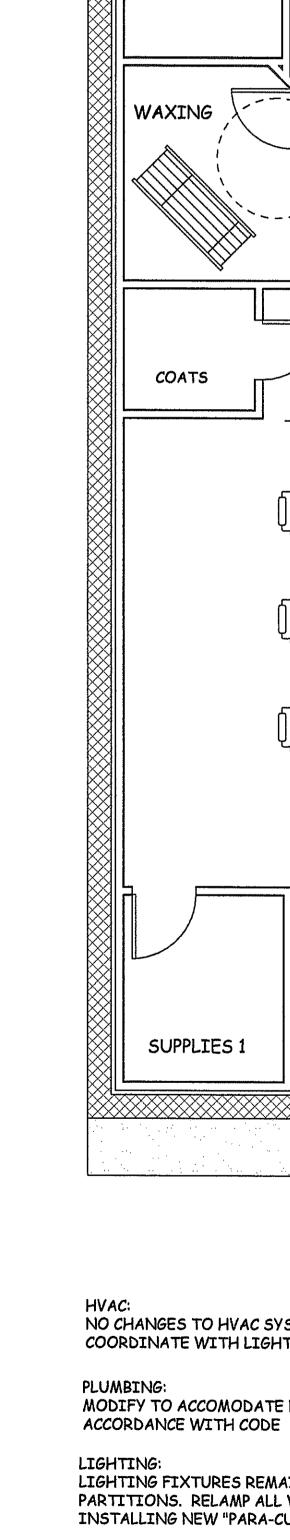

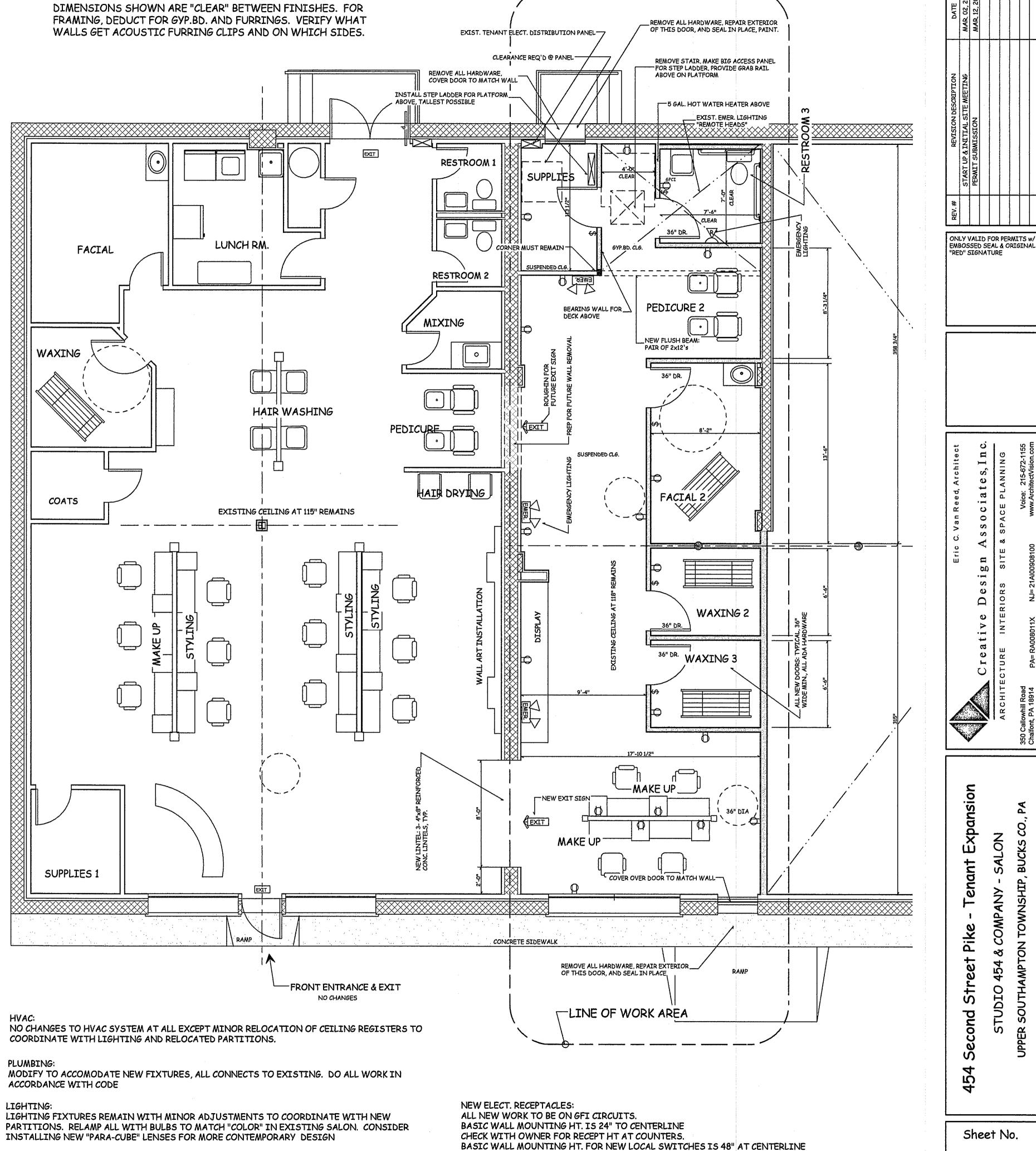
